

## ART EXHIBITION OPPORTUNITY FOR ARTISTS UP – ARTISTS!

### Background:

Cornish College of the Arts is committed to the outreach and support of our local community of artists in both the visual and performing arts. Our wish is to create a group exhibition from October 16th-November 19th. We are reaching out to artists that have been a part of [Artist Up](#) program by the 4Culture & the Seattle Office of Arts & Culture. ### Provisions available:

- Gallery Space: There are four gallery walls that have designated slots to hang from, and a supply of 50 hooks for the use in this endeavor. Scaled drawings of the walls are available. There are also a few pedestals and/or floor space for any three dimensional work.
- Installation: Work study students will help with the installation and the de-installation of the artwork.
- Labeling: Cornish Playhouse Gallery will create the labels. Information on the work will be collected after selection process.
- Insurance: The artwork is covered under Cornish College of the Arts' insurance while on display at the Cornish Playhouse Gallery.
- Storage: There is limited storage available for packing items.
- Marketing: We will create a poster and help advertise the exhibition, citing the Artist UP program, via social media and through the Seattle Center.
- Complimentary Tickets: Two tickets to a fall Cornish student production of *It Can't Happen Here* will be provided to each artist. Oct. 25-Nov. 3, 2017.

### Provisions not available:

- Open Hours: The Cornish Playhouse Gallery hours will be only during Cornish ticketed events, with the exception of the exhibition opening, which will be free and open to the public.
- Selling: We do not have the staffing available to sell the artwork included in the exhibition. Instead, please provide contact information for your label. Business cards are a great alternative.
